NOTICE:

- ⇒ Exhibits will be released Sunday, July 30th @ 10:00am-12:30pm.
- ⇒ The purchase of any products is for bidden. These must be grown by grangers.
- ⇒ Floor covering may be of natural materials, such as alfalfa, etc. or can be made of manmade materials.
- ⇒ Bible must be displayed closed.
- ⇒ Flag is to be displayed in all booths and to be to the left of the booth as you face it.
- ⇒ Ribbons, or anything won by the grange, may be displayed.
- ⇒ Achievements must be for the past year and Goals must be for the coming year.
- ⇒ Achievements and Goals will not be judged on the basis of what they

were, but that each grange had Goals and Achievements and may be displayed anywhere in the booth.

- ⇒ Permitted to change flowers - or water deteriorating products, Replace as needed.
