- ⇒ All exhibitors must be enrolled in the 4-H Cat Project.
- ⇒ Cats must show at the pre-judging unless they are in season. Cats will not be on display at the fair.
- ⇒ Cats must have certification of rabies and distemper inoculation.
- Exhibitors must make something to go along with their cat project or a poster and exhibit this item in the Small Animal Building in a booth during the fair. Bring project book and be able to answer questions about the project.
- ⇒ Cats must be on a harness or collar and leash or in a cage at all times on the Fairgrounds.

Requirements:

Bring small animal to judging; exhibit a poster during fair week
