Vollmer reported the hotel rooms for the OFMA convention in January will be in the Sonesta hotel. Wells moved to pay each director and Carrie Robinson \$50.00 per day per diem for meals. Mignery second the motion, everyone voted yes. The board listened to a presentation from LRT (Lithco Restoration Technologies) about the grandstand restoration project. They presented different options for the planning and design process and areas that should be priorities to be fixed. The board will discuss these plans at the meeting in Columbus.
