## 2024 CAMPER FEES AND RULES

## Butler County Fair July 21st - 27<sup>th</sup> 2024

#### Horse Camping - Member in Charge: Chad Idle

Livestock Camping - Members in Charge: Doug Turner & David Vollmer

#### Curfew in camp grounds is 12:00 midnight.

1. Camping fee for the week of the fair is:

\$300.00 (Infield Camping)

\$225.00 (Fence Camping)

\$250.00 (Horse Camping 1)

\$300.00 (Horse Camping 2)

Do not include with any other fees. Fee must accompany application.

- Absolutely no motorized vehicles (ATV,RTV,golf carts) permitted on fair grounds.
- Fee does not include Fair entry. Everyone staying in camper must have and hold a ticket for the week. Tickets must be 4-day, 7-day, Membership, Jr. Fair, or Jr. Fair Advisor Pass. Must be Fair Participant.
- 4. 2024 Campers requesting same location should have application & payment to the Fair Office by the Jr. Fair Entry Deadline. If you do not reserve your space by the deadline, it will be made available to others. If size or type of camper is different than previous year, same location, or space cannot be guaranteed.
- New Applicants: New camping applications will be accepted at the fair office, either in person, by Postal Mail or emailed (<u>butlercoun-tyohfair@gmail.com</u>). No faxed applications will be accepted. This will add your name to the waiting list. Camper spaces will be awarded based on camper size, space, availability and date application received.
- 6. Horse Area ONLY: <u>Club Camping Spaces During the Fair.</u> Camping Selections will take place at the May Advisor Meeting at the Fairgrounds. All Paperwork and Payments will be due at the time of selection. The Order of the Camping Selection Process will go as follows:
- ${\it 1.} Advisor\ Board\ Officers\ will\ select\ in\ the\ Order\ of\ \ President,}$  Vice President, Secretary, then Treasurer.
  - 2. Jr. Fairboard Advisor(s)
- 3. Jr. Fairboard Members (Excluding Barn Superintendents). Order will be based on the following criteria:
  - a. Seniority
  - b. Meeting Attendance
  - c. Participation in Fundraisers & Community Service Projects
- 4. Committee Chairpersons/Advisors
- 5.Club Advisors, with preference to the Advisors based on the following criteria:
  - a. Working at Horse Events
  - b. Attendance at the 4H Advisor Meetings from June of one year through May of the following year
- c. Horse Participant Fee of \$10 per member enrolled as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, including Horseless Horse. This fee is to be turned in on later than May Advisor Meeting.

# NO SLEEPING IN ANY VEHCILES OTHER THAN THOSE IN RENTED CAMPER SPOTS.

- Campers <u>MAY</u> move in Friday before the start of Fair, You may <u>NOT</u> move in prior to this, unless you are Authorized Fair Personnel
- 8. All fire lanes must be kept open at all times.
- 9. No pets are allowed in camping area.
- 10. Quiet hours begin at 12:00 midnight.
- 11. Drugs, drug-related substances and alcohol are strictly prohibited upon the fairgrounds (including parking and camping areas). Matters concerning drugs, drug-related substances and/or alcohol, or evidence or suspicion of any type or nature of the same, shall be referred to a director or directors of the Agricultural Society or its duly authorized agents for disposition. Any action to be taken on the mat-

ter is within the sole discretion of the Directors of the Agricultural Society, and such actions may include, without limit, the following:

- a) Referral of the matter to law enforcement authorities.
- b) Notice to parents and/or guardians.
- c) Removal from the fairgrounds.
- d) Bar from participating in any manner in future fairs..
- e) Forfeiture of any awards and/or prize money.
- 12. Air conditioners will be permitted.
- Electric hook-ups are to be proper receptacles only, and only one camping unit per extension cord. Use only UL approve extension cord. NO Generators allowed unless authorized by Fairboard.
- Premises around camping area are to be kept clean and sanitary.
  Trash can be placed in proper containers. No dumping of holding tanks will be permitted.
- 15. No open fires permitted.
- Room for slide-outs and awnings is not guaranteed. Only if space is available.
- 17. No person staying in a camper may cause a disturbance, nuisance or annoyance as determined by the sole discretion of any members of the Board of Directors of the Agricultural Society or their duly authorized agents.
- 18. The Butler County Agricultural Society is not liable in any way for any actions, losses, damages, or claims of any type which might arise as a result of a person using the Fairground facilities for camping.
- No subletting of camper space is permitted. Cannot give space to someone else.
- 20. Space is for camper only. No other vehicles.
- 21. Sitting on top of campers is prohibited due to safety/liability issues.
- DO NOT unplug someone else's camper. If you have a problem, please contact a Fairboard Member.
- 23. The above rules will be enforced by the Directors of the Butler County Agricultural Society and/or its authorized agents. The Society reserves the right to take whatever action it deems appropriate, in its sole discretion, to remedy any concern in the camping area which shall include, without limit, the following: to immediately terminate or cancel the rental arrangement, to have the applicant or camper removed from the premises, to reject or refuse camper rental privileges to any applicant.
